

Examination, Admission, and Tuition Fee etc. for Research Students

1. Fees

Examination Fee:	9,800 JPY (Please pay at the time of the exam application procedure.)
Admission Fee:	84,600 JPY (Please pay by the due date specified based on the Notice of Enrollment Procedures)
Tuition Fees	29,700 JPY /per month (The payment process is as follows.)

2. How to pay the tuition fee

- (1) Research Students must pay the tuition in advance in each three-month-installments starting from the month of enrollment. Tuition payment must be made within the first month of each installment.
- (2) Please pay the tuition by an automatic bank withdrawal from a domestic bank account in Japan. For this procedure, you need to follow “Automatic Tuition Fee Payment Procedure Guide” and register your domestic bank account at the time of enrollment. If you do not have a Japanese bank account, please register as soon as possible after opening it.
- (3) Only for the first payment of tuition, please pay it by a bank transfer from a domestic bank account in Japan. If you do not have a Japanese bank account, you can use a credit card as well.
- (4) Please note that if you need a receipt, please ask to the accounting section of School of Medicine.

3. Tuition Fee Payment Processing Dates

Payment processing dates of the tuition change depending on the year. Just for your information, the dates for AY2023 are as below. Exact schedule would be notified when you enroll in Tohoku University.

Please note that unpaid tuition fees will result in expulsion from the university.

4. Others

- (1) In addition to the above fees, you are required to purchase some insurances, “GAKKENSAI”(1,000 JPY/ year) and “Inbound futai-gakuso (Type B)” (11,500 JPY/ year) specified by Tohoku University.
- (2) Once you paid the Examination and Admission fees, no refunds will be made. (Tohoku University Research Student Guidelines Article 10)
- (3) Once you paid the tuition fee, no refunds will be made. (Tohoku University Research Student Guidelines Article 16, Paragraph 4)
- (4) **If you already have plan to withdraw from the university in the middle of your expected enrollment term, or if you intend to withdraw from the university, please be sure to talk to the Graduate Academic Affairs Section, Undergraduate / Graduate School of Medicine in advance.** You must pay the tuition up to the month you wish to withdraw from the university and submit the prescribed withdrawal form. Depending on the payment situation, you may be required to pay tuition fee for the months after the month in which you wish to withdraw.
- (5) If you submit your withdrawal request early, some case you may receive a tuition exemption. So please notify us as soon as possible after you decide to withdraw.
- (6) **If you will be hired by Tohoku University as a medical staff member, assistant, etc., you need to withdraw from the university as a research student.**
- (7) Please note that it is not possible to process withdrawal retroactively to a date prior to the time of withdrawal request.
